

Guidance for your Glider Flight

Before you come to the airfield

- If you want to see what to expect, watch this video (<https://youtu.be/a1ioy50iFFs>). Please note that it was made before the Covid restrictions and does not include some of the guidance below.
- Fill in the online declaration – we need this for insurance and Covid-19 track and trace purposes (at http://tiny.cc/SGC_I0001_form).
- Make sure you and your party wear suitable clothing for outdoors.

When you arrive

- No more than 4 people in the group, including the person flying.
- Arrive no more than 10 minutes before your allotted time.
- On arrival follow the signs and stop at the blue flag.
- A club representative will meet you, confirm your details and guide you to park and go to a designated picnic table with your group.
 - If there is an easterly wind, you will be escorted in your car to the far end of the airfield to park and go to a picnic table there.
- If there is a delay, you may be asked to wait in your car until a table is free.

Getting ready

- Stay at the picnic table and observe social distancing with other groups.
- When your glider is ready, your instructor will take you and your group to the aircraft.
- Before leaving the table, please use the hand sanitizer provided.
- Wear a face mask while getting into the glider (a disposable mask can be provided)
 - Some gliders have a perspex screen between you and the pilot. In that case you can take the facemask off once you are in the glider. If there is no screen you must wear a facemask for the duration of the flight
- Your instructor will assist in putting on the parachute and boarding the glider.
- Your aircraft will have been disinfected since the last flight.

After your flight

- The glider will be towed back to the launch point and your instructor will answer any questions. Please vacate your picnic table as soon as you return.
- Exit the airfield by the main road and please observe the 10mph speed limit.

We hope that you and your party enjoy your flight experience, and as a club we endeavour to make your experience as safe and enjoyable as possible, so please feel free to engage with our volunteers and make this a day to remember.
